

SPEYSIDE SINGLE MALT SCOTCH WHISKY

Tamdhu was historically distinguished by its use of sherry cask maturation, a tradition that continues to define its whisky today. Due to this distinction some have likened it to Macallan





THE DISTILLERY

Tamdhu Distillery was founded in 1897 during Scotland's late 19th-century whisky boom. A group of whisky investors, including William Grant, recognized the potential of a distillery in Speyside, an area renowned for its high-quality whisky production. Designed by the famous distillery architect Charles Doig, Tamdhu was built with state-of-the-art equipment and innovation in mind.

The name "Tamdhu" comes from Gaelic, meaning "little dark hill," referencing the surrounding landscape. From the beginning, Tamdhu was distinguished by its use of sherry cask maturation, a tradition that continues to define its whisky today.

In 1899, Highland Distillers acquired Tamdhu, and for much of its history, the distillery primarily produced whisky for blending, contributing to famous brands like The Famous Grouse and Cutty Sark. Despite challenges such as World Wars and economic downturns, Tamdhu remained operational for most of the 20th century.

However, in 2010, its then-owner, the Edrington Group, mothballed the distillery. A year later, Ian Macleod Distillers purchased Tamdhu and revitalized it, refocusing on single malt production. Since then, Tamdhu has reestablished itself as a premium whisky brand, maintaining its commitment to sherry cask maturation in casks that are primarily imported from Spain.

Distillery Tasting Notes

Nose C

On the nose, enjoy the softness of vanilla and sugared almonds, balanced by fresh oak and cinnamon.

Taste

The taste finishes with a touch of fresh fruit, becoming pleasantly drying – slowly unveiling the wisp of peat smoke.

Finish

The palate bursts with fruit and spice – gently revealing toffee and the richness of sherry oak.

Cask Oloroso Sherry

Combining American Oak Oloroso and European Oak Oloroso casks, the 18-Year-Old unites Tamdhu's signature fruity spirit and 18 long years of full-term sherry maturation to deliver layers of indulgent flavour and a deep natural colour which reflects the quality of the oak.

Distillery Tasting Notes

Nose Dry nutty sherry, cherry, milk chocolate, rum

raisin, citrus, baked oats and plum.

Taste Long and warming, dried apricot and dates,

soft spice and stewed apple.

Finish Sherry notes are rich, complex and

mouthcoating with vanilla, brown sugar, red

apple and dried fruits.

golden syrup.

Taste Sherry-soaked winter fruits, giving way to

rich malt loaf topped with vanilla cream.

Finish Honeyed apricots, then toasted nuts.
